SECOND CIRCULAR

Considering the date and format change of the Conference, as well as the following administrative measures that were necessary in this second circular, we want to reiterate that the VI CIDS – The International Dialectology and Sociolinguistics Conference is going to take place from November 7 – 10, 2022 remotely, with a few face-to-face activities at the Federal University of Mato Grosso do Sul with the theme: *Linguistic variation: intercultural contact, research and teaching*. The VI CIDS will pay homage to Dr. João Antonio das Pedras Saramago, researcher at the University of Lisbon Center for Linguistics, and Dr. Dinah Maria Isensee Callou, professor and researcher at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro.

The VI CIDS program will feature four plenary conferences, four twin conferences, 16 round tables, 16 mini-courses, individual communications, posters, tribute sessions, as well as book/magazine launches and artistic and cultural activities, as detailed on the event's website: <https://cids.ufms.br/pagina-inicial/>

Oral communications and posters must be linked to the theme of the congress, *Linguistic variation: intercultural contacts, research and teaching* and must be included in one of the thematic axes – 1. Dialectology; 2. Sociolinguistics; 3. Interfaces.

Registration (with research presentation) for VI CIDS is expected to start **August 15th. 2022.**

Detailed instructions for online registration will be available on the event website **as of this date.**

Registration period

- August 15 to October 15, 2022 (registration with research submission – communication and poster)
- August 15, 2022 to November 05, 2022 (mini-course registrations)
- August 15, 2022 to November 5, 2022 (register as auditor)

Research presentation categories

Individual communication:

- Category designed for professors, researchers and postgraduate students (Master's or PhD).
- The time designated for oral expositions is 20 minutes (15 minutes for presenting and 5 minutes for discussions).

Posters:

- Modality for undergraduate students (in co-authorship with the advising professor), however, other categories can also sign up in this modality.
- Panels must show a self-explanatory research summary and must be specifically formatted and sent in advance to be published on the VI CIDS website. Panels approved by the Scientific Committee and meeting the presentation rules will be exhibited throughout the event, with free access to Conference participants.

Instructions for presenting abstracts

- The proposed research must be linked to one of the thematic areas of the Conference and be presented in one of the event's official languages (Portuguese, English, French or Spanish)
- The abstract must contain the object of study, objectives, theoretical foundations, research methodology and the results obtained.
- The abstract, for any of the modalities, must have the following characteristics:
a) minimum of 300 words and maximum of 500 words; b) font: Arial 12; c) keywords: 3 to 5; d) title in UPPERCASE and BOLD.

Other information about presenting research

- The acceptance letter approved by the Scientific Commission will be sent to the e-mail registered by the participants.
- Each participant can present to research proposals as an author and up to five proposals as a co-author. Notify when the research is co-authored with advisor.
- Oral communications, approved by the Scientific communication, based on abstracts must be presented by at least one of the registered authors.

Mini-courses

- Activity designed for undergraduate and postgraduate students, K-12 teachers and other interested professionals.
- Mini-courses are given by guests who are involved in the event areas. The program is available on the event website.
- Mini-course registration can be done separately from event registration.
- Participants with at least 75% attendance receive a certificate.

Registration period and price

- The registration price varies with date and category according to the following table.
- For the registration payment of foreign participants the system of registration will automatically convert to REAL, considering the fixed exchange rate of R\$ 5,20, already including internacional financial services.
